

Application for 5-year Bachelor/Master Degrees in Engineering

To apply for the 5 year Bachelor/Master program:

- 1) You must have (and maintain) a cumulative QPA of 3.25 or greater
- 2) You must have earned at least 85 credit hours and be in good standing with the University
- 3) You must be within 2-3 academic terms of expected graduation
- 4) You must be able to complete your Bachelor degree in 4 years, and Master degree at the end of the 5th year.
- 5) You must have (and maintain) a cumulative QPA of 3.25 or greater
- 6) You must submit a copy of a term-by-term senior plan with this application.

The 5-year Bachelor/Master Degree program allows students three distinct advantages:

- Reduction in the total number of courses required to complete both the bachelor and master degrees. *(Up to three courses may be counted towards both undergraduate and graduate requirements. Soft. Eng may only double-count one course)*
- Ability to take up to three graduate courses at the undergraduate tuition rate .
- Extension of UDM financial aid to include the year of graduate study.
