## Instructions for Applicants to MPD Program

### Qualifications for Admission to MPD Degree Program

- BS or higher in engineering or computer science and 5 or more years of work experience in industry, government, or academia. Alternate qualifications include MS in engineering with 3 or more years of work experience in industry, government, or academia
- Applicants with degrees in other related technical fields would be considered on an exception basis. In those cases, decisions will emphasize both math and analytical contents of their education and their work experience.

*The selection committee will consider the overall preparedness of the candidate in making admission decisions. This will be based on candidate's academic background, work experience, leadership initiatives, letter of recommendation from his/her supervisor/manager along with the other documents submitted.*

### All Applicants:

1. Fill out completely the UDM Graduate Application for Admission.
2. Fill out the Supplemental Application.
3. Arrange to have one copy of official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions (whether degree program or single courses taken) sent to UDM.
4. Attach a listing of all training courses that you might have taken since graduation.
5. Arrange to have a letter of recommendation filled out by your supervisor/manager and returned to UDM. Evaluations should be completed by individuals who can comment with some certainty about your intellectual and professional achievements and leadership potential.
6. Enclose an up-to-date resume with your application to UDM.
7. Return the application package to the address below.

### Deadlines

Prospective students are encouraged to send in their application as early as possible. The "rolling admission process" start on **May 15, 2000** and will continue until established class size is attained. Selected candidates will be notified on a "rolling basis" monthly starting **June 1, 2000**.
