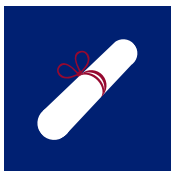




SEED

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AT UNIVERSITY OF DETROIT MERCY

The Science and Engineering Equity Development (SEED) scholarship program supports the success of academically talented students with demonstrated financial need in the fields of **computer science, engineering and mathematics**. Qualifying students will receive full undergraduate tuition for four years, in addition to three paid co-operative summer internships and mentoring from an impressive lineup of corporate partners, including Ford Motor Company, Walbridge, A2Mac1, RIIS and Roush.

Requirements

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Admitted to Computer Science, Engineering or Mathematics at Detroit Mercy
- Demonstrated financial need via FAFSA (Pell eligible)
- Minimum 3.3 GPA, 1060 SAT (Math 560) or 23 ACT *
